CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE, ALSO KNOWN AS THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, IS A WIDELY ADOPTED CITATION METHOD THAT PROVIDES A CLEAR AND EFFICIENT WAY TO ACKNOWLEDGE SOURCES WITHIN ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL WRITING. THIS SYSTEM, A CRUCIAL COMPONENT OF THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE, RELIES ON CONCISE IN-TEXT CITATIONS THAT DIRECT READERS TO A COMPREHENSIVE BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST. UNDERSTANDING ITS NUANCES IS PARAMOUNT FOR RESEARCHERS, STUDENTS, AND ANYONE AIMING FOR ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND SCHOLARLY COMMUNICATION. 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UNDERSTANDING THE CHICAGO STYLE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE OFFERS TWO PRIMARY CITATION SYSTEMS: THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM AND THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM. THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM, AS ITS NAME SUGGESTS, PRIORITIZES BREVITY IN THE MAIN TEXT BY EMPLOYING PARENTHETICAL CITATIONS THAT INCLUDE THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE PUBLICATION YEAR. THIS APPROACH IS PARTICULARLY FAVORED IN CERTAIN ACADEMIC DISCIPLINES, SUCH AS THE SOCIAL SCIENCES AND NATURAL SCIENCES, WHERE FREQUENT REFERENCING IS COMMON AND THE READER NEEDS QUICK ACCESS TO SOURCE INFORMATION WITHOUT EXTENSIVE FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES INTERRUPTING THE FLOW OF THE NARRATIVE. IT ALLOWS FOR A CLEANER PRESENTATION OF THE MAIN ARGUMENT WHILE STILL PROVIDING THE NECESSARY ATTRIBUTION.

THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE BEHIND THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM IS TO LINK THE IN-TEXT CITATION DIRECTLY TO A FULL BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY. THIS DIRECT CONNECTION IS VITAL FOR READERS WHO WISH TO CONSULT THE ORIGINAL SOURCES. THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM AIMS FOR CLARITY AND EASE OF USE, ALLOWING AUTHORS TO CONCISELY INDICATE THE SOURCE OF THEIR INFORMATION WITHOUT OVERWHELMING THE READER WITH LENGTHY FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES. THE EMPHASIS IS ON PROVIDING SUFFICIENT INFORMATION IN THE PARENTHESES TO UNIQUELY IDENTIFY THE SOURCE AND DIRECTING THE READER TO THE COMPLETE ENTRY IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHY.

CORE COMPONENTS OF CHICAGO STYLE AUTHOR-DATE CITATIONS

THE EFFICACY OF THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM HINGES ON TWO PRIMARY COMPONENTS: THE IN-TEXT CITATION AND THE BIBLIOGRAPHY. EACH PLAYS A DISTINCT YET COMPLEMENTARY ROLE IN THE OVERALL CITATION PROCESS. THE IN-TEXT CITATION ACTS AS A BRIEF MARKER, WHILE THE BIBLIOGRAPHY PROVIDES THE EXHAUSTIVE DETAILS REQUIRED FOR FULL IDENTIFICATION AND RETRIEVAL OF THE SOURCE. WITHOUT BOTH PARTS WORKING IN TANDEM, THE SYSTEM WOULD BE INCOMPLETE AND INEFFECTIVE FOR PROPER ACADEMIC REFERENCING.

THE IN-TEXT CITATION

THE IN-TEXT CITATION IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM IS TYPICALLY ENCLOSED IN PARENTHESES. IT GENERALLY INCLUDES THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION. FOR EXAMPLE, A CITATION MIGHT APPEAR AS (SMITH 2020). THIS FORMAT IS DESIGNED TO BE UNOBTRUSIVE, ALLOWING THE TEXT TO FLOW SMOOTHLY. HOWEVER, WHEN QUOTING DIRECTLY OR REFERENCING SPECIFIC IDEAS, ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SUCH AS THE PAGE NUMBER IS CRUCIAL FOR PINPOINTING THE EXACT LOCATION WITHIN THE SOURCE, MAKING THE CITATION MORE SPECIFIC AND USEFUL FOR THE READER.

WHEN AN AUTHOR HAS MULTIPLE WORKS PUBLISHED IN THE SAME YEAR, A LOWERCASE LETTER IS APPENDED TO THE YEAR TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN THEM. FOR INSTANCE, (JONES 2019A) AND (JONES 2019B). THIS METICULOUS DETAIL ENSURES THAT EVEN SIMILAR PUBLICATIONS BY THE SAME AUTHOR IN THE SAME YEAR CAN BE ACCURATELY DIFFERENTIATED. THIS LEVEL OF SPECIFICITY IS ESSENTIAL FOR AVOIDING AMBIGUITY AND MAINTAINING THE INTEGRITY OF THE CITATION PROCESS, ESPECIALLY IN EXTENSIVE BIBLIOGRAPHIES.

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY OR REFERENCE LIST

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY, ALSO KNOWN AS A REFERENCE LIST IN THE AUTHOR-DATE SYSTEM, IS A COMPREHENSIVE ALPHABETICAL LIST OF ALL SOURCES CITED WITHIN THE TEXT. EACH ENTRY PROVIDES COMPLETE PUBLICATION DETAILS, INCLUDING THE AUTHOR'S FULL NAME, THE TITLE OF THE WORK, PUBLICATION INFORMATION (SUCH AS PUBLISHER, PLACE OF PUBLICATION, JOURNAL NAME, VOLUME, AND ISSUE), AND PAGE NUMBERS WHERE APPLICABLE. THIS DETAILED LISTING ALLOWS READERS TO LOCATE AND VERIFY THE SOURCES USED IN THE PAPER.

THE FORMAT OF EACH BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM VARIES DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF SOURCE (E.G., BOOK, JOURNAL ARTICLE, WEBSITE, CHAPTER IN AN EDITED BOOK). HOWEVER, THE CORE PRINCIPLE REMAINS CONSISTENT: TO PROVIDE ENOUGH INFORMATION FOR RETRIEVAL. CONSISTENCY IN FORMATTING ACROSS ALL ENTRIES IS PARAMOUNT FOR A PROFESSIONAL AND EASILY NAVIGABLE BIBLIOGRAPHY. THIS REQUIRES CAREFUL ATTENTION TO DETAIL AND ADHERENCE TO THE SPECIFIC GUIDELINES FOR EACH SOURCE TYPE.

CONSTRUCTING IN-TEXT CITATIONS

CREATING ACCURATE IN-TEXT CITATIONS IS FUNDAMENTAL TO THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM. THE PRIMARY GOAL IS TO OFFER A BRIEF BUT SUFFICIENT IDENTIFIER FOR THE SOURCE BEING REFERENCED. THIS INVOLVES UNDERSTANDING HOW TO FORMAT CITATIONS FOR VARIOUS TYPES OF SOURCES AND HOW TO INTEGRATE THEM SMOOTHLY INTO YOUR PROSE.

BASIC AUTHOR-YEAR FORMAT

THE MOST COMMON FORM OF IN-TEXT CITATION IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM INVOLVES PLACING THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME AND THE PUBLICATION YEAR IN PARENTHESES AT THE END OF THE SENTENCE OR CLAUSE THAT CONTAINS THE BORROWED INFORMATION. FOR INSTANCE, RESEARCH INDICATES A SIGNIFICANT TREND (DAVIS 2021). IF THE AUTHOR'S NAME IS MENTIONED IN THE TEXT, IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO REPEAT IT IN THE PARENTHESES, BUT THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION SHOULD STILL BE INCLUDED. FOR EXAMPLE: DAVIS (2021) FOUND THAT THE TREND WAS SIGNIFICANT.

CITATIONS WITH PAGE NUMBERS

WHEN DIRECTLY QUOTING FROM A SOURCE OR WHEN REFERRING TO A SPECIFIC IDEA OR PIECE OF INFORMATION THAT CAN BE EASILY LOCATED, INCLUDING THE PAGE NUMBER IS CRUCIAL. THIS PROVIDES A PRECISE REFERENCE POINT FOR THE READER. THE FORMAT TYPICALLY BECOMES (AUTHOR LAST NAME YEAR, PAGE NUMBER). FOR EXAMPLE, A DIRECT QUOTE MIGHT BE PRESENTED AS: "THE IMPLICATIONS OF THIS FINDING ARE FAR-REACHING" (MILLER 2018, 45). FOR PARAPHRASED IDEAS WHERE A SPECIFIC PAGE IS RELEVANT, THE FORMAT REMAINS THE SAME.

MULTIPLE AUTHORS

CITATIONS FOR WORKS WITH MULTIPLE AUTHORS FOLLOW SPECIFIC RULES. FOR TWO AUTHORS, BOTH NAMES ARE USUALLY INCLUDED, CONNECTED BY "AND" WITHIN THE PARENTHESES: (ANDERSON AND BROWN 2019). FOR THREE OR MORE AUTHORS, THE CONVENTION IS TO LIST ONLY THE FIRST AUTHOR'S LAST NAME FOLLOWED BY "ET AL." (LATIN FOR "AND OTHERS"): (CHEN ET AL. 2022). THIS HELPS TO KEEP THE IN-TEXT CITATIONS CONCISE, ESPECIALLY WHEN DEALING WITH WORKS THAT HAVE NUMEROUS CONTRIBUTORS.

WORKS WITHOUT AUTHORS OR DATES

IN SITUATIONS WHERE A WORK LACKS AN AUTHOR, THE CITATION OFTEN BEGINS WITH THE TITLE OF THE WORK, OR A SHORTENED VERSION OF IT, FOLLOWED BY THE YEAR. FOR EXAMPLE, (A COMPREHENSIVE GUIDE TO CITATION 2020). IF A WORK LACKS A PUBLICATION DATE, "N.D." (NO DATE) IS USED IN PLACE OF THE YEAR: (GARCIA N.D.). THESE EXCEPTIONS ENSURE THAT ALL REFERENCED MATERIAL CAN STILL BE IDENTIFIED, EVEN IF THE STANDARD CITATION ELEMENTS ARE MISSING.

CRAFTING THE BIBLIOGRAPHY

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY IS THE BACKBONE OF THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM, PROVIDING THE COMPLETE BIBLIOGRAPHIC DETAILS FOR EVERY SOURCE CITED IN THE TEXT. ITS THOROUGHNESS AND ACCURACY ARE PARAMOUNT FOR ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND READER ASSISTANCE. EACH ENTRY MUST BE METICULOUSLY FORMATTED ACCORDING TO THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE GUIDELINES FOR THE SPECIFIC SOURCE TYPE.

ALPHABETICAL ORDER

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY MUST BE ARRANGED IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER BY THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME. IF A WORK HAS NO AUTHOR, IT IS ALPHABETIZED BY THE FIRST SIGNIFICANT WORD OF THE TITLE, IGNORING ARTICLES LIKE "A," "AN," AND "THE." THIS SYSTEMATIC ORGANIZATION MAKES IT EASY FOR READERS TO LOCATE SPECIFIC ENTRIES QUICKLY AND EFFICIENTLY, CONTRIBUTING TO THE OVERALL USABILITY OF THE CITATION SYSTEM.

FORMATTING FOR DIFFERENT SOURCE TYPES

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE OUTLINES SPECIFIC FORMATTING RULES FOR A WIDE ARRAY OF SOURCE TYPES. THESE INCLUDE BOOKS, JOURNAL ARTICLES, MAGAZINE ARTICLES, NEWSPAPER ARTICLES, WEBSITES, BOOK CHAPTERS, DISSERTATIONS, AND MORE. EACH TYPE REQUIRES A PARTICULAR ARRANGEMENT OF INFORMATION, SUCH AS AUTHOR'S FULL NAME, TITLE OF THE WORK, PUBLICATION DETAILS, AND ACCESS INFORMATION FOR ONLINE RESOURCES. ADHERING TO THESE DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS ENSURES CONSISTENCY AND PROFESSIONALISM.

- **BOOKS:** AUTHOR LAST NAME, FIRST NAME. YEAR. *TITLE OF BOOK*. PLACE OF PUBLICATION: PUBLISHER.
- **JOURNAL ARTICLES:** AUTHOR LAST NAME, FIRST NAME. YEAR. "TITLE OF ARTICLE." *TITLE OF JOURNAL* VOLUME, NO. ISSUE (MONTH): PAGE NUMBERS.
- **WEBSITES:** AUTHOR LAST NAME, FIRST NAME (IF AVAILABLE). YEAR (OR N.D.). "TITLE OF WEB PAGE." NAME OF WEBSITE. DATE OF LAST UPDATE OR ACCESS DATE. URL.

THESE EXAMPLES REPRESENT THE BASIC STRUCTURE, BUT THE FULL DETAILS FOR EACH ELEMENT, INCLUDING PUNCTUATION AND CAPITALIZATION, MUST BE CAREFULLY FOLLOWED AS PER THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE.

COMMON SCENARIOS AND VARIATIONS

WHILE THE CORE PRINCIPLES OF THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM ARE STRAIGHTFORWARD, CERTAIN COMMON SCENARIOS AND VARIATIONS REQUIRE SPECIFIC ATTENTION TO DETAIL. UNDERSTANDING THESE EXCEPTIONS ENSURES ACCURATE AND CONSISTENT CITATION PRACTICES THROUGHOUT YOUR WORK.

WORKS BY THE SAME AUTHOR

WHEN CITING MULTIPLE WORKS BY THE SAME AUTHOR, THE BIBLIOGRAPHY LISTS THEM CHRONOLOGICALLY BY PUBLICATION DATE. FOR WORKS PUBLISHED IN THE SAME YEAR, THEY ARE FURTHER DISTINGUISHED BY APPENDING LOWERCASE LETTERS (A, B,

C) TO THE YEAR, BOTH IN THE IN-TEXT CITATIONS AND THE BIBLIOGRAPHY ENTRIES. THIS CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER HELPS READERS UNDERSTAND THE AUTHOR'S INTELLECTUAL DEVELOPMENT OR THE PROGRESSION OF THEIR RESEARCH OVER TIME.

CORPORATE AUTHORS AND EDITORS

FOR WORKS AUTHORED BY AN ORGANIZATION OR INSTITUTION RATHER THAN AN INDIVIDUAL, THE ORGANIZATION'S NAME IS USED AS THE AUTHOR. FOR EDITED VOLUMES WHERE YOU ARE CITING A CHAPTER, THE AUTHOR OF THE CHAPTER IS CITED FIRST, FOLLOWED BY THE EDITOR(S) IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY, AND THE CHAPTER'S TITLE. THE IN-TEXT CITATION WILL STILL PRIMARILY RELY ON THE CHAPTER AUTHOR'S NAME AND THE PUBLICATION YEAR, UNLESS THE SPECIFIC CONTEXT WARRANTS REFERENCING THE EDITOR OR THE OVERALL VOLUME.

SECONDARY SOURCES

WHEN CITING A WORK THAT YOU ACCESSED THROUGH ANOTHER SOURCE (E.G., QUOTING SOMEONE WHO IS CITED IN A BOOK YOU READ), THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM REQUIRES YOU TO CITE THE SECONDARY SOURCE IN YOUR IN-TEXT CITATION AND BIBLIOGRAPHY. HOWEVER, IF POSSIBLE, IT IS ALWAYS BEST PRACTICE TO CONSULT AND CITE THE ORIGINAL SOURCE DIRECTLY. IF YOU MUST CITE A SECONDARY SOURCE, THE FORMAT MIGHT LOOK LIKE (ORIGINAL AUTHOR, AS CITED IN SECONDARY AUTHOR YEAR, PAGE). THE BIBLIOGRAPHY WILL ONLY LIST THE SECONDARY SOURCE.

BEST PRACTICES FOR USING CHICAGO STYLE AUTHOR-DATE

IMPLEMENTING THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM EFFECTIVELY REQUIRES MORE THAN JUST KNOWING THE RULES; IT INVOLVES ADOPTING BEST PRACTICES THAT ENSURE CLARITY, CONSISTENCY, AND PROFESSIONALISM IN YOUR ACADEMIC WRITING. THESE PRACTICES ENHANCE THE READER'S EXPERIENCE AND STRENGTHEN THE CREDIBILITY OF YOUR RESEARCH.

CONSISTENCY IS KEY

UTILIZE CITATION MANAGEMENT TOOLS

FOR EXTENSIVE RESEARCH PROJECTS, MANAGING CITATIONS CAN BECOME A DAUNTING TASK. CITATION MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE, SUCH AS ZOTERO, MENDELEY, OR ENDNOTE, CAN BE INVALUABLE. THESE TOOLS HELP YOU ORGANIZE YOUR SOURCES, GENERATE CITATIONS IN VARIOUS STYLES (INCLUDING CHICAGO AUTHOR-DATE), AND CREATE BIBLIOGRAPHIES AUTOMATICALLY, SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCING THE RISK OF ERRORS AND SAVING CONSIDERABLE TIME.

PROOFREAD METICULOUSLY

BEFORE SUBMITTING ANY WORK, IT IS IMPERATIVE TO PROOFREAD YOUR IN-TEXT CITATIONS AND BIBLIOGRAPHY THOROUGHLY. CHECK FOR ANY TYPOS, MISSING INFORMATION, OR FORMATTING ERRORS. A FINAL, CAREFUL REVIEW CAN CATCH MISTAKES THAT MIGHT OTHERWISE GO UNNOTICED AND COULD POTENTIALLY COMPROMISE THE ACCURACY OF YOUR CITATIONS.

CONSULT THE OFFICIAL MANUAL

THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE IS THE DEFINITIVE GUIDE FOR THIS CITATION SYSTEM. WHEN IN DOUBT ABOUT A SPECIFIC FORMATTING RULE OR AN UNUSUAL SOURCE TYPE, ALWAYS REFER TO THE LATEST EDITION OF THE MANUAL. WHILE ONLINE RESOURCES CAN BE HELPFUL, THE OFFICIAL MANUAL PROVIDES THE MOST ACCURATE AND COMPREHENSIVE GUIDANCE.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF CHICAGO STYLE AUTHOR-DATE IN ACADEMIC WRITING

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE

THE NOTES-BIBLIOGRAPHY SYSTEM IS MORE OFTEN USED IN THE HUMANITIES, SUCH AS LITERATURE, HISTORY, AND THE ARTS, WHERE CITATIONS MIGHT BE LESS FREQUENT AND A MORE DETAILED EXPLANATORY NOTE IS SOMETIMES DESIRED.

Q: HOW DO I CITE A SOURCE WITH NO AUTHOR IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM?

A: IF A SOURCE HAS NO AUTHOR, YOU TYPICALLY BEGIN THE IN-TEXT CITATION AND THE BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY WITH THE TITLE OF THE WORK, OR A SHORTENED VERSION OF IT. FOR EXAMPLE, IN-TEXT WOULD BE (A COMPREHENSIVE GUIDE 2020) AND THE BIBLIOGRAPHY ENTRY WOULD START WITH "A COMPREHENSIVE GUIDE."

Q: WHAT IF I AM CITING A WORK PUBLISHED BY AN ORGANIZATION INSTEAD OF AN INDIVIDUAL AUTHOR IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM?

A: WHEN A WORK IS ATTRIBUTED TO AN ORGANIZATION, INSTITUTION, OR GOVERNMENT AGENCY, THAT NAME IS USED AS THE AUTHOR IN BOTH THE IN-TEXT CITATION AND THE BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY. FOR EXAMPLE, (WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION 2019).

Q: HOW DO I HANDLE CITING MULTIPLE WORKS BY THE SAME AUTHOR IN THE SAME YEAR USING THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM?

A: YOU SHOULD APPEND LOWERCASE LETTERS (A, B, C, ETC.) TO THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN THE WORKS. FOR EXAMPLE, (SMITH 2021A) AND (SMITH 2021B). THESE LETTERS MUST ALSO BE USED IN THE CORRESPONDING BIBLIOGRAPHY ENTRIES.

Q: IS IT PERMISSIBLE TO USE "ET AL." IN IN-TEXT CITATIONS FOR WORKS WITH MANY AUTHORS IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM?

A: YES, FOR WORKS WITH THREE OR MORE AUTHORS, IT IS STANDARD PRACTICE TO LIST ONLY THE FIRST AUTHOR'S LAST NAME FOLLOWED BY "ET AL." IN THE IN-TEXT CITATION (E.G., CHEN ET AL. 2022). HOWEVER, IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHY, ALL AUTHORS' NAMES SHOULD BE LISTED UNLESS THE MANUAL SPECIFIES OTHERWISE FOR A PARTICULAR SOURCE TYPE OR NUMBER OF AUTHORS.

Q: WHAT IS THE CORRECT WAY TO CITE A DIRECT QUOTE WITH A PAGE NUMBER IN THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM?

A: A DIRECT QUOTE CITATION INCLUDES THE AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, THE YEAR OF PUBLICATION, AND THE PAGE NUMBER, SEPARATED BY COMMAS AND ENCLOSED IN PARENTHESES. FOR EXAMPLE: (JOHNSON 2018, 78).

Q: DO I NEED TO INCLUDE ACCESS DATES FOR ONLINE SOURCES IN THE BIBLIOGRAPHY WHEN USING THE CHICAGO STYLE FOOTNOTE AUTHOR DATE SYSTEM?

A: INCLUDING AN ACCESS DATE FOR ONLINE SOURCES IS OFTEN RECOMMENDED, ESPECIALLY IF THE CONTENT IS LIKELY TO CHANGE OR BE UPDATED FREQUENTLY. IT IS TYPICALLY PLACED AT THE END OF THE BIBLIOGRAPHIC ENTRY, AFTER THE URL. THE EXACT FORMAT FOR ACCESS DATES CAN VARY SLIGHTLY DEPENDING ON THE SPECIFIC ONLINE SOURCE TYPE AND THE EDITION OF THE CHICAGO MANUAL OF STYLE BEING USED.

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
