## PSYCHOANALYTIC AND FEMINIST INTERPRETATIONS

A: STUDYING ART HISTORY FROM A POST-COLONIAL PERSPECTIVE INVOLVES CRITICALLY EXAMINING THE IMPACT OF COLONIALISM AND IMPERIALISM ON ART AND ART HISTORICAL NARRATIVES. IT SEEKS TO DECENTER WESTERN PERSPECTIVES, AMPLIFY MARGINALIZED VOICES, AND ANALYZE HOW ART HAS BEEN USED TO RESIST, NEGOTIATE, OR REFLECT COLONIAL POWER STRUCTURES AND THEIR ENDURING LEGACIES.

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
