HISTORICAL CONTEXT: THE GENESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

TRANSFORMATION, WHILE BRINGING ABOUT TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS, ALSO CREATED VAST DISPARITIES IN WEALTH AND LIVING CONDITIONS. FACTORIES BECAME CENTERS OF PRODUCTION, BUT ALSO SITES OF INTENSE LABOR EXPLOITATION, WITH LONG HOURS, LOW WAGES, AND DANGEROUS WORKING ENVIRONMENTS BEING THE NORM. THE BURGEONING CAPITALIST SYSTEM, WITH ITS EMPHASIS ON PRIVATE OWNERSHIP AND PROFIT ACCUMULATION, WAS CREATING A NEW SOCIAL ORDER CHARACTERIZED BY THE STARK DIVISION BETWEEN THOSE WHO OWNED THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION AND THOSE WHO SOLD THEIR LABOR.

THE RISE OF INDUSTRIAL CAPITALISM

THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION, BEGINNING IN GREAT BRITAIN AND SPREADING ACROSS THE CONTINENT, WAS THE FERTILE GROUND FROM WHICH MARXIST IDEOLOGY, AND THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO SPECIFICALLY, EMERGED. NEW TECHNOLOGIES LIKE THE STEAM ENGINE, POWER LOOM, AND LATER, ADVANCEMENTS IN STEEL PRODUCTION, REVOLUTIONIZED MANUFACTURING. THIS LED TO THE MASS PRODUCTION OF GOODS AND THE CONCENTRATION OF CAPITAL IN THE HANDS OF A FEW. THE FACTORY SYSTEM FOSTERED A NEW RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE, ONE THAT MARX AND ENGELS CHARACTERIZED AS INHERENTLY EXPLOITATIVE. THE PURSUIT OF PROFIT OFTEN OVERSHADOWED THE WELL-BEING OF THE WORKERS, LEADING TO WIDESPREAD POVERTY AND DISCONTENT AMONG THE WORKING CLASSES.

PRECURSORS TO MARXIST THOUGHT

MARX AND ENGELS DID NOT OPERATE IN A VACUUM. THEIR IDEAS WERE BUILT UPON AND CRITIQUED EXISTING PHILOSOPHICAL AND ECONOMIC THOUGHT. THEY ENGAGED WITH THE IDEAS OF EARLIER SOCIALISTS, SUCH AS HENRI DE SAINT-SIMON, CHARLES FOURIER, AND ROBERT OWEN, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS UTOPIAN SOCIALISTS. WHILE APPRECIATING THEIR CRITIQUES OF CAPITALISM AND THEIR VISIONS FOR A MORE EQUITABLE SOCIETY, MARX AND ENGELS FOUND THESE APPROACHES TO BE IDEALISTIC AND LACKING A CONCRETE HISTORICAL ANALYSIS. THEY SOUGHT TO DEVELOP A MORE SCIENTIFIC APPROACH TO UNDERSTANDING SOCIETAL CHANGE, GROUNDED IN HISTORICAL MATERIALISM, WHICH POSITS THAT ECONOMIC AND MATERIAL CONDITIONS ARE THE PRIMARY DRIVERS OF HISTORY AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES. UNDERSTANDING THESE INTELLECTUAL PRECURSORS IS VITAL FOR COMPREHENDING THE UNIQUE CONTRIBUTION OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO TO THE DISCOURSE ON POLITICAL IDEOLOGY.

CORE PRINCIPLES OF COMMUNISM AS PRESENTED IN THE MANIFESTO

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS RENOWNED FOR ITS CONCISE YET POWERFUL ARTICULATION OF THE CORE PRINCIPLES OF COMMUNISM. AT ITS HEART LIES A SWEEPING CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM AND A VISION FOR A CLASSLESS SOCIETY. THE DOCUMENT SYSTEMATICALLY DISMANTLES THE EXISTING SOCIAL ORDER, ARGUING THAT IT IS INHERENTLY FLAWED AND DESTINED FOR COLLAPSE. IT PROPOSES A REVOLUTIONARY PATH FORWARD, ADVOCATING FOR THE ABOLITION OF CERTAIN SOCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW SOCIETAL STRUCTURE BASED ON COMMUNAL OWNERSHIP AND EQUALITY. THE PRINCIPLES OUTLINED ARE NOT MERELY THEORETICAL; THEY ARE PRESENTED AS THE INEVITABLE OUTCOME OF HISTORICAL FORCES.

THE SPECTER OF COMMUNISM

THE OPENING LINES OF THE MANIFESTO FAMOUSLY DECLARE THAT "A SPECTER IS HAUNTING EUROPE—THE SPECTER OF COMMUNISM." THIS IMAGERY IMMEDIATELY ESTABLISHES COMMUNISM AS A FORCE THAT IS BOTH FEARED BY THE RULING CLASSES AND EMBRACED BY THE OPPRESSED. IT SIGNIFIES THE GROWING AWARENESS AND MOBILIZATION OF THE WORKING CLASS, WHO ARE BEGINNING TO RECOGNIZE THEIR COLLECTIVE POWER AND THE INJUSTICES THEY FACE UNDER THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM. THIS "SPECTER" REPRESENTS THE POTENTIAL FOR RADICAL SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION AND THE OVERTHROW OF EXISTING POWER STRUCTURES, MAKING IT A PIVOTAL CONCEPT IN UNDERSTANDING THE MANIFESTO'S IMMEDIATE IMPACT AND ITS ROLE IN SHAPING POLITICAL IDEOLOGY.

HISTORICAL MATERIALISM AS A FRAMEWORK

A CORNERSTONE OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS THE CONCEPT OF HISTORICAL MATERIALISM. MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT THE PRIMARY DRIVING FORCE OF HISTORY IS THE DEVELOPMENT OF MATERIAL CONDITIONS, SPECIFICALLY THE MODES OF PRODUCTION AND THE RESULTING CLASS RELATIONS. THEY BELIEVED THAT ECONOMIC SYSTEMS, SUCH AS FEUDALISM AND CAPITALISM, ARE NOT STATIC BUT EVOLVE THROUGH INTERNAL CONTRADICTIONS AND CLASS CONFLICT. EACH HISTORICAL EPOCH IS CHARACTERIZED BY A DOMINANT MODE OF PRODUCTION, AND THE TRANSITION FROM ONE EPOCH TO ANOTHER IS DRIVEN BY THE STRUGGLES BETWEEN THE CLASSES THAT EMERGE FROM THESE MODES. THIS ANALYTICAL FRAMEWORK IS CENTRAL TO UNDERSTANDING HOW THE MANIFESTO PREDICTS THE INEVITABLE DOWNFALL OF CAPITALISM AND THE RISE OF COMMUNISM.

CLASS STRUGGLE: THE ENGINE OF HISTORY

PERHAPS THE MOST ENDURING AND RECOGNIZED TENET OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS ITS ASSERTION THAT "THE HISTORY OF ALL HITHERTO EXISTING SOCIETY IS THE HISTORY OF CLASS STRUGGLES." THIS STATEMENT ENCAPSULATES THE CENTRAL THESIS OF THE DOCUMENT, POSITING THAT CONFLICT BETWEEN SOCIAL CLASSES IS THE FUNDAMENTAL ENGINE OF HISTORICAL PROGRESS. MARX AND ENGELS METICULOUSLY TRACE THIS CONFLICT THROUGH VARIOUS HISTORICAL EPOCHS, FROM ANCIENT SLAVE SOCIETIES TO FEUDALISM, AND FINALLY, TO THE CAPITALIST ERA THEY WERE ANALYZING. THEY ARGUED THAT EACH SOCIETAL SYSTEM CONTAINS INHERENT TENSIONS BORN FROM THE UNEQUAL DISTRIBUTION OF POWER AND RESOURCES, LEADING TO PERPETUAL CONFLICT.

THE OPPRESSOR AND THE OPPRESSED

THE MANIFESTO DETAILS THE CYCLICAL NATURE OF CLASS STRUGGLE, IDENTIFYING A FUNDAMENTAL DIVISION BETWEEN THE OPPRESSOR CLASS AND THE OPPRESSED CLASS IN EVERY HISTORICAL PERIOD. IN ANCIENT TIMES, THIS WAS THE MASTER AND THE SLAVE. IN THE MIDDLE AGES, IT WAS THE LORD AND THE SERF. UNDER CAPITALISM, THE CENTRAL DYNAMIC IS THE CONFLICT BETWEEN THE BOURGEOISIE, THE OWNERS OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, AND THE PROLETARIAT, THE WAGE LABORERS WHO SELL THEIR LABOR POWER. THIS BINARY UNDERSTANDING OF CLASS IS CRUCIAL FOR GRASPING THE MANIFESTO'S CALL FOR PROLETARIAN REVOLUTION AS THE MEANS TO DISMANTLE THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM AND USHER IN A NEW ERA.

THE BOURGEOISIE'S REVOLUTIONARY ROLE

INTERESTINGLY, THE MANIFESTO ALSO ACKNOWLEDGES THE REVOLUTIONARY ROLE PLAYED BY THE BOURGEOISIE IN OVERTHROWING FEUDALISM. IT RECOGNIZES THAT THE CAPITALIST CLASS, IN ITS QUEST FOR PROFIT AND EXPANSION, SHATTERED FEUDAL BONDS, CREATED NEW MARKETS, AND DEVELOPED UNPRECEDENTED PRODUCTIVE FORCES. HOWEVER, THE MANIFESTO ARGUES THAT THE VERY FORCES UNLEASHED BY THE BOURGEOISIE HAVE NOW CREATED THE CONDITIONS FOR THEIR OWN DEMISE. THE PROLETARIAT, A CLASS ALSO CREATED BY THE BOURGEOISIE, HAS BECOME INCREASINGLY ORGANIZED AND POWERFUL, POISED TO OVERTHROW THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM THAT SPAWNED IT. THIS DIALECTICAL VIEW OF HISTORY, WHERE THE POSITIVE DEVELOPMENTS OF ONE CLASS SOW THE SEEDS OF ITS OWN DESTRUCTION, IS A KEY ELEMENT OF MARXIST THEORY.

THE ROLE OF THE PROLETARIAT AND THE BOURGEOISIE

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO PLACES IMMENSE EMPHASIS ON THE DISTINCT ROLES AND INEVITABLE CONFLICT BETWEEN THE BOURGEOISIE AND THE PROLETARIAT. THESE TWO CLASSES ARE NOT SIMPLY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES BUT ARE PRESENTED AS CENTRAL ACTORS IN THE GRAND NARRATIVE OF HISTORICAL PROGRESSION, DRIVING THE DIALECTICAL PROCESS TOWARDS A COMMUNIST FUTURE. THE MANIFESTO METICULOUSLY DETAILS THE CHARACTERISTICS, POWER DYNAMICS, AND ULTIMATE DESTINIES OF BOTH THESE SOCIETAL SEGMENTS.

THE BOURGEOISIE: CREATORS AND CONQUERORS

THE MANIFESTO DESCRIBES THE BOURGEOISIE AS THE DOMINANT CLASS IN CAPITALIST SOCIETY. THEY ARE THE OWNERS OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION – FACTORIES, LAND, MACHINERY, AND CAPITAL. THEIR PRIMARY MOTIVATION IS THE ACCUMULATION OF PROFIT, WHICH THEY ACHIEVE BY EXPLOITING THE LABOR OF THE PROLETARIAT. THE MANIFESTO ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE HAS PLAYED A HISTORICALLY PROGRESSIVE ROLE, BREAKING DOWN FEUDAL STRUCTURES AND CREATING A GLOBAL MARKET. HOWEVER, IT ALSO HIGHLIGHTS THE INHERENT INSTABILITY OF CAPITALISM, CHARACTERIZED BY PERIODIC CRISES OF OVERPRODUCTION AND THE INCREASING IMMISERATION OF THE WORKING CLASS. THE BOURGEOISIE'S RELENTLESS PURSUIT OF PROFIT AND EXPANSION IS PORTRAYED AS A FORCE THAT, WHILE INITIALLY LIBERATING, ULTIMATELY BECOMES A SOURCE OF SOCIETAL ALIENATION AND EXPLOITATION.

THE PROLETARIAT: THE REVOLUTIONARY CLASS

THE PROLETARIAT, ON THE OTHER HAND, IS DEFINED AS THE CLASS OF WAGE LABORERS WHO POSSESS NO MEANS OF PRODUCTION OF THEIR OWN. THEY ARE COMPELLED TO SELL THEIR LABOR POWER TO THE BOURGEOISIE IN ORDER TO SURVIVE. THE MANIFESTO PAINTS A STARK PICTURE OF THE PROLETARIAT'S CONDITION: ALIENATION FROM THEIR LABOR, FROM THE PRODUCTS OF THEIR LABOR, FROM EACH OTHER, AND FROM THEIR OWN HUMAN POTENTIAL. HOWEVER, IT ALSO IDENTIFIES THE PROLETARIAT AS THE ONLY TRULY REVOLUTIONARY CLASS. BECAUSE THEY HAVE NOTHING TO LOSE BUT THEIR CHAINS, AND BECAUSE THEIR COLLECTIVE LABOR IS ESSENTIAL TO THE FUNCTIONING OF CAPITALISM, THEY ARE UNIQUELY POSITIONED TO OVERTHROW THE BOURGEOISIE AND ESTABLISH A NEW SOCIETY. THE MANIFESTO CALLS FOR THE PROLETARIAT TO UNITE AND ORGANIZE, RECOGNIZING THEIR SHARED INTERESTS AND THEIR IMMENSE POTENTIAL POWER.

ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY AND ITS IMPLICATIONS

ONE OF THE MOST CONTROVERSIAL AND CENTRAL PROPOSALS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS THE CALL FOR THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY. HOWEVER, IT IS CRUCIAL TO UNDERSTAND WHAT MARX AND ENGELS MEANT BY "PRIVATE PROPERTY" IN THIS CONTEXT. THEY WERE NOT ADVOCATING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF PERSONAL POSSESSIONS, SUCH AS CLOTHES OR TOOLS. INSTEAD, THEY TARGETED THE PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION, WHICH THEY SAW AS THE VERY FOUNDATION OF CAPITALIST EXPLOITATION AND CLASS DIVISION.

DEFINING "PRIVATE PROPERTY" IN THE MANIFESTO

THE MANIFESTO CLARIFIES THAT WHEN IT SPEAKS OF ABOLISHING "BOURGEOIS PROPERTY," IT REFERS TO THE PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF CAPITAL AND THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION BY THE FEW. THIS IS THE PROPERTY THAT ALLOWS THE BOURGEOISIE TO EXPLOIT THE LABOR OF OTHERS. THEY ARGUE THAT THIS FORM OF PROPERTY IS NOT THE PRODUCT OF INDIVIDUAL EFFORT BUT RATHER A RESULT OF THE COLLECTIVE LABOR OF THE WORKING CLASS, APPROPRIATED BY THE OWNERS OF CAPITAL. THEREFORE, THE ABOLITION OF THIS SPECIFIC TYPE OF PROPERTY IS SEEN NOT AS A DEPRIVATION BUT AS A RECLAIMING OF WHAT RIGHTFULLY BELONGS TO SOCIETY AS A WHOLE.

COMMUNAL OWNERSHIP AND THE END OF EXPLOITATION

THE IMPLICATION OF ABOLISHING PRIVATE PROPERTY, AS ENVISIONED BY THE MANIFESTO, IS THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMUNAL OWNERSHIP OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION. THIS WOULD MEAN THAT FACTORIES, LAND, AND RESOURCES WOULD BE OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY SOCIETY COLLECTIVELY, RATHER THAN BY INDIVIDUAL CAPITALISTS. THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS TO END THE SYSTEM OF EXPLOITATION WHERE ONE CLASS PROFITS FROM THE LABOR OF ANOTHER. BY REMOVING PRIVATE OWNERSHIP, THE MANIFESTO POSITS THAT SOCIETY CAN MOVE TOWARDS A MORE EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF WEALTH AND RESOURCES, AND ULTIMATELY, THE ERADICATION OF CLASS DISTINCTIONS. THIS FUNDAMENTAL SHIFT IN OWNERSHIP IS PRESENTED AS THE NECESSARY PRECURSOR TO A COMMUNIST SOCIETY WHERE THE PRINCIPLE "FROM EACH ACCORDING TO HIS ABILITY, TO EACH ACCORDING TO HIS NEEDS" CAN BE REALIZED.

THE STATE AND ITS PROPOSED DEMISE

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO ALSO OFFERS A RADICAL PERSPECTIVE ON THE ROLE AND EVENTUAL FATE OF THE STATE. ACCORDING TO THE ANALYSIS PRESENTED, THE STATE IS NOT AN IMPARTIAL ARBITER OF SOCIAL JUSTICE BUT RATHER AN INSTRUMENT OF THE RULING CLASS, DESIGNED TO MAINTAIN ITS DOMINANCE AND PROTECT ITS INTERESTS.

THE STATE AS AN INSTRUMENT OF CLASS RULE

MARX AND ENGELS ARGUE THAT THROUGHOUT HISTORY, THE STATE HAS SERVED AS THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE BOURGEOISIE. ITS LAWS, INSTITUTIONS, AND ENFORCEMENT MECHANISMS ARE ALL DESIGNED TO UPHOLD THE EXISTING PROPERTY RELATIONS AND SUPPRESS ANY THREATS TO THE CAPITALIST SYSTEM. THE STATE, IN THEIR VIEW, IS A TOOL USED BY THE DOMINANT CLASS TO MAINTAIN ITS POWER AND TO PERPETUATE THE EXPLOITATION OF THE WORKING CLASS. THIS PERSPECTIVE CHALLENGES THE TRADITIONAL UNDERSTANDING OF THE STATE AS A NEUTRAL ENTITY THAT SERVES THE COMMON GOOD.

THE WITHERING AWAY OF THE STATE

THE ULTIMATE GOAL OF THE PROLETARIAN REVOLUTION, AS OUTLINED IN THE MANIFESTO, IS NOT MERELY TO SEIZE STATE POWER BUT TO ABOLISH THE STATE ITSELF. ONCE THE BOURGEOISIE IS OVERTHROWN AND THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION ARE COMMUNALLY OWNED, THE NEED FOR A COERCIVE APPARATUS TO ENFORCE CLASS DIVISIONS WILL DISAPPEAR. IN A CLASSLESS SOCIETY, WHERE EXPLOITATION IS ELIMINATED, THE STATE, AS AN INSTRUMENT OF CLASS RULE, WILL BECOME OBSOLETE. IT WILL "WITHER AWAY," REPLACED BY A SYSTEM OF VOLUNTARY ASSOCIATION AND COMMUNAL SELF-GOVERNANCE. THIS CONCEPT OF THE "WITHERING AWAY OF THE STATE" IS A FUNDAMENTAL TENET OF MARXIST THEORY, DIFFERENTIATING IT FROM OTHER POLITICAL IDEOLOGIES THAT SEEK TO REFORM OR STRENGTHEN THE STATE.

CRITIQUES AND CONTROVERSIES SURROUNDING COMMUNIST IDEOLOGY

DESPITE ITS PROFOUND HISTORICAL INFLUENCE, THE IDEOLOGY PRESENTED IN THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO HAS BEEN SUBJECT TO EXTENSIVE CRITICISM AND INTENSE CONTROVERSY. THE PRACTICAL IMPLEMENTATIONS OF MARXIST-INSPIRED REVOLUTIONS IN THE 20TH CENTURY HAVE LED TO WIDESPREAD DEBATE ABOUT THE FEASIBILITY AND DESIRABILITY OF COMMUNIST IDEALS, RAISING SIGNIFICANT QUESTIONS ABOUT THE DOCUMENT'S ENDURING RELEVANCE AND THE NATURE OF POLITICAL IDEOLOGY.

HISTORICAL IMPLEMENTATIONS AND THEIR OUTCOMES

CRITICS OFTEN POINT TO THE HISTORICAL RECORD OF STATES THAT HAVE ATTEMPTED TO IMPLEMENT COMMUNIST POLICIES, SUCH AS THE SOVIET UNION, CHINA, AND CUBA, AS EVIDENCE OF THE IDEOLOGY'S INHERENT FLAWS. THESE IMPLEMENTATIONS OFTEN RESULTED IN AUTHORITARIAN REGIMES, SUPPRESSION OF INDIVIDUAL LIBERTIES, ECONOMIC INEFFICIENCIES, AND WIDESPREAD HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES. THE DISCONNECT BETWEEN THE MANIFESTO'S UTOPIAN VISION OF A CLASSLESS SOCIETY AND THE HARSH REALITIES OF THESE STATES HAS FUELED MUCH OF THE CRITICISM DIRECTED AT COMMUNIST IDEOLOGY. UNDERSTANDING THESE HISTORICAL OUTCOMES IS CRUCIAL FOR A BALANCED ASSESSMENT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO'S IMPACT.

ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL OBJECTIONS

ECONOMICALLY, CRITICS ARGUE THAT THE ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY AND THE CENTRAL PLANNING OF ECONOMIES STIFLE INNOVATION, REDUCE EFFICIENCY, AND LEAD TO SHORTAGES OF GOODS AND SERVICES. THEY CONTEND THAT THE PROFIT MOTIVE, WHILE CREATING INEQUALITY, IS ALSO A POWERFUL INCENTIVE FOR PRODUCTIVITY AND ECONOMIC GROWTH. POLITICALLY, OBJECTIONS OFTEN CENTER ON THE CONCENTRATION OF POWER THAT CAN OCCUR IN SYSTEMS ATTEMPTING TO ELIMINATE CLASS DISTINCTIONS. THE CONCEPT OF THE "DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT," WHILE INTENDED AS A TEMPORARY MEASURE TO TRANSITION TO COMMUNISM, HAS HISTORICALLY LED TO ENTRENCHED DICTATORSHIPS AND THE SUPPRESSION OF DISSENT, WHICH IS ANTITHETICAL TO DEMOCRATIC IDEALS.

THE PERSISTENCE OF CLASS AND HUMAN NATURE ARGUMENTS

ANOTHER COMMON CRITIQUE QUESTIONS THE MARXIST ASSERTION THAT CLASS STRUGGLE IS THE PRIMARY DRIVER OF HISTORY AND THAT IT CAN ULTIMATELY BE ELIMINATED. SOME ARGUE THAT HUMAN NATURE, WITH ITS INHERENT TENDENCIES TOWARDS SELF-INTEREST AND COMPETITION, MAKES A TRULY CLASSLESS SOCIETY UNATTAINABLE. FURTHERMORE, CRITICS SUGGEST THAT EVEN IN THE ABSENCE OF ECONOMIC CLASSES, OTHER FORMS OF SOCIAL STRATIFICATION, BASED ON POWER, STATUS, OR IDEOLOGY, WILL INEVITABLY EMERGE. THESE ARGUMENTS CONTINUE TO BE POINTS OF CONTENTION IN DISCUSSIONS ABOUT POLITICAL IDEOLOGY AND THE POTENTIAL FOR SOCIETAL TRANSFORMATION.

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO'S ENDURING INFLUENCE AND LEGACY

THE FEUDAL ARISTOCRACY. HOWEVER, IT ARGUES THAT THE BOURGEOISIE HAS CREATED A SYSTEM WHERE THEY EXPLOIT THE PROLETARIAT (THE WORKING CLASS) FOR PROFIT, LEADING TO THE CONCENTRATION OF WEALTH AND POWER IN THEIR HANDS.

WHAT DOES THE MANIFESTO MEAN BY 'ABOLITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY'?

THE MANIFESTO ADVOCATES FOR THE ABOLITION OF 'BOURGEOIS PRIVATE PROPERTY,' WHICH REFERS TO THE PRIVATE OWNERSHIP OF THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION (Factories, land, etc.) BY CAPITALISTS. IT DOES NOT MEAN THE ABOLITION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY, LIKE ONE'S CLOTHES OR HOME, BUT RATHER THE COLLECTIVE OWNERSHIP AND CONTROL OF PRODUCTIVE ASSETS BY SOCIETY.

WHAT IS THE PREDICTED OUTCOME OF THE CLASS STRUGGLE ACCORDING TO THE MANIFESTO?

ACCORDING TO THE MANIFESTO, THE INEVITABLE OUTCOME OF THE INTENSIFIED CLASS STRUGGLE BETWEEN THE BOURGEOISIE AND THE PROLETARIAT IS A REVOLUTION.
