

COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IMPACT ON HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, A FOUNDATIONAL TEXT IN POLITICAL THEORY, HAS IRREVOCABLY SHAPED HOW HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS ARE UNDERSTOOD, WRITTEN, AND INTERPRETED. ITS INFLUENCE EXTENDS FAR BEYOND THE REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENTS IT DIRECTLY INSPIRED, PERMEATING ACADEMIC DISCOURSE AND THE VERY NARRATIVES WE CONSTRUCT ABOUT THE PAST. BY INTRODUCING CONCEPTS LIKE CLASS STRUGGLE, HISTORICAL MATERIALISM, AND THE INEVITABLE PROGRESSION OF SOCIETAL STAGES, MARX AND ENGELS PROVIDED A NEW LENS THROUGH WHICH TO EXAMINE HUMAN HISTORY. THIS ARTICLE DELVES INTO THE PROFOUND AND MULTIFACETED IMPACT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO ON HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS, EXPLORING HOW ITS ANALYTICAL FRAMEWORK HAS BEEN ADOPTED, DEBATED, AND CHALLENGED ACROSS CENTURIES. WE WILL EXAMINE ITS ROLE IN SHAPING HISTORIOGRAPHY, ITS INFLUENCE ON SPECIFIC HISTORICAL ANALYSES, AND THE ONGOING RELEVANCE OF ITS CORE IDEAS IN UNDERSTANDING HISTORICAL CHANGE. UNDERSTANDING THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO'S IMPACT IS CRUCIAL FOR GRASPING THE EVOLUTION OF HISTORICAL THOUGHT AND THE PERSISTENT QUEST TO INTERPRET THE HUMAN PAST.

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THE HISTORICAL CONTEXT AND GENESIS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

PUBLISHED IN 1848, THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO EMERGED FROM A SPECIFIC HISTORICAL MILIEU CHARACTERIZED BY BURGEONING INDUSTRIAL CAPITALISM, WIDESPREAD SOCIAL UNREST, AND THE RISE OF SOCIALIST THOUGHT. KARL MARX AND FRIEDRICH ENGELS, COMMISSIONED BY THE COMMUNIST LEAGUE, SOUGHT TO ARTICULATE A CLEAR AND FORCEFUL PROGRAM FOR THE WORKING CLASS. THE DOCUMENT WAS NOT BORN IN A VACUUM BUT WAS A DIRECT RESPONSE TO THE PREVAILING SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC CONDITIONS OF THE MID-19TH CENTURY. THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION HAD CREATED NEW CLASSES, EXACERBATED INEQUALITIES, AND FUELED A SENSE OF ALIENATION AMONG THE PROLETARIAT. THE MANIFESTO AIMED TO PROVIDE A THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK THAT EXPLAINED THESE TRANSFORMATIONS AND OFFERED A REVOLUTIONARY SOLUTION. ITS INITIAL RECEPTION WAS MIXED, BUT ITS IDEAS GRADUALLY PERMEATED INTELLECTUAL AND POLITICAL CIRCLES, LAYING THE GROUNDWORK FOR ITS PROFOUND IMPACT ON HOW HISTORY WOULD SUBSEQUENTLY BE WRITTEN AND UNDERSTOOD.

CORE TENETS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO AND THEIR HISTORIOGRAPHICAL IMPLICATIONS

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO IS BUILT UPON SEVERAL CORE THEORETICAL PILLARS THAT, WHEN APPLIED TO HISTORY, FUNDAMENTALLY ALTERED THE WAY PAST EVENTS WERE ANALYZED. THESE TENETS PROVIDED A POWERFUL ANALYTICAL TOOLKIT FOR UNDERSTANDING SOCIETAL CHANGE, HUMAN MOTIVATION, AND THE DRIVING FORCES BEHIND HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT. THEIR ADOPTION, EVEN BY THOSE WHO DISAGREED WITH THE ULTIMATE POLITICAL CONCLUSIONS, RESHAPED THE LANDSCAPE OF HISTORICAL INQUIRY.

HISTORICAL MATERIALISM: THE BEDROCK OF MARXIST HISTORIOGRAPHY

PERHAPS THE MOST SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO TO HISTORICAL ANALYSIS IS THE CONCEPT OF HISTORICAL MATERIALISM. THIS THEORY POSITS THAT THE PRIMARY DETERMINANT OF HISTORY IS THE DEVELOPMENT OF MATERIAL CONDITIONS, SPECIFICALLY THE MEANS OF PRODUCTION AND THE RELATIONS OF PRODUCTION. MARX AND ENGELS ARGUED THAT THE ECONOMIC BASE OF SOCIETY—ITS MODE OF PRODUCTION—SHAPES ITS SOCIAL, POLITICAL, AND INTELLECTUAL SUPERSTRUCTURE. IN ESSENCE, HOW SOCIETIES PRODUCE THE NECESSITIES OF LIFE DICTATES THEIR LAWS, CULTURE, AND EVEN THEIR CONSCIOUSNESS. THIS PERSPECTIVE SHIFTED THE FOCUS OF HISTORICAL INQUIRY FROM THE ACTIONS OF GREAT MEN OR DIVINE PROVIDENCE TO THE UNDERLYING ECONOMIC FORCES AND THE MATERIAL CONDITIONS THAT SHAPE HUMAN LIVES. HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS INFLUENCED BY THIS TENET TEND TO EXAMINE THE EVOLUTION OF ECONOMIC SYSTEMS, THE DEVELOPMENT OF TECHNOLOGY, AND THE IMPACT OF THESE ON SOCIAL STRUCTURES AND HUMAN RELATIONSHIPS.

CLASS STRUGGLE AS THE ENGINE OF HISTORY

ANOTHER CENTRAL TENET OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO, INEXTRICABLY LINKED TO HISTORICAL MATERIALISM, IS THE IDEA THAT HISTORY IS FUNDAMENTALLY A HISTORY OF CLASS STRUGGLES. MARX AND ENGELS FAMOUSLY DECLARED, "THE HISTORY OF ALL HITHERTO EXISTING SOCIETY IS THE HISTORY OF CLASS STRUGGLES." THEY ARGUED THAT IN EVERY SOCIETY, THERE HAVE BEEN DOMINANT AND SUBORDINATE CLASSES, AND THE CONFLICT BETWEEN THESE CLASSES HAS BEEN THE PRIMARY DRIVER OF HISTORICAL CHANGE. FROM THE ANCIENT SLAVE OWNER AND SLAVE TO THE FEUDAL LORD AND SERF, AND FINALLY TO THE BOURGEOIS CAPITALIST AND THE PROLETARIAT, THESE ANTAGONISMS HAVE PROPELLED SOCIETIES FORWARD, LEADING TO REVOLUTIONS AND THE EVENTUAL EMERGENCE OF NEW SOCIAL ORDERS. THIS CONCEPT ENCOURAGED HISTORIANS TO LOOK BEYOND THE SURFACE-LEVEL EVENTS AND IDENTIFY THE UNDERLYING SOCIAL CONFLICTS, POWER DYNAMICS, AND ECONOMIC INEQUALITIES THAT FUELED HISTORICAL TRANSFORMATIONS. ACCOUNTS THAT EMBRACED THIS PERSPECTIVE SOUGHT TO

UNCOVER THE EXPERIENCES AND STRUGGLES OF THE OPPRESSED, NOT JUST THE NARRATIVES OF THE RULING ELITE.

THE CONCEPT OF HISTORICAL STAGES AND SOCIETAL PROGRESSION

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO ALSO OUTLINED A THEORY OF HISTORICAL PROGRESSION, POSITING THAT SOCIETIES MOVE THROUGH DISTINCT STAGES, EACH CHARACTERIZED BY A PARTICULAR MODE OF PRODUCTION AND CLASS STRUCTURE. THEY IDENTIFIED PRIMITIVE COMMUNISM, SLAVERY, FEUDALISM, AND CAPITALISM AS PRECEDING STAGES, WITH COMMUNISM ENVISIONED AS THE ULTIMATE AND INEVITABLE FUTURE. THIS TELEOLOGICAL VIEW OF HISTORY, WHILE LATER SUBJECT TO SIGNIFICANT CRITIQUE, PROVIDED A FRAMEWORK FOR ORGANIZING AND INTERPRETING HISTORICAL EVENTS WITHIN A BROADER DEVELOPMENTAL NARRATIVE. IT SUGGESTED A PATTERN AND A DIRECTION TO HUMAN HISTORY, OFFERING A SENSE OF ORDER AND CAUSALITY THAT RESONATED WITH MANY HISTORIANS. THE IDEA OF A LINEAR PROGRESSION, DRIVEN BY THE INTERNAL CONTRADICTIONS OF EACH STAGE AND THE ENSUING CLASS STRUGGLE, OFFERED A COMPELLING MODEL FOR EXPLAINING THE VAST SWEEP OF HUMAN EXPERIENCE.

THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO'S IMPACT ON TRADITIONAL HISTORICAL NARRATIVES

THE PUBLICATION OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO AND THE SUBSEQUENT SPREAD OF MARXIST IDEAS HAD A PROFOUND IMPACT ON THE WAY HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS WERE TRADITIONALLY CONCEIVED AND WRITTEN. BEFORE MARX, HISTORICAL NARRATIVES OFTEN FOCUSED ON POLITICAL EVENTS, MILITARY CAMPAIGNS, AND THE DEEDS OF PROMINENT INDIVIDUALS, TYPICALLY ROYALTY, STATESMEN, AND MILITARY LEADERS. THE MANIFESTO OFFERED A RADICAL DEPARTURE, DEMANDING A RE-EXAMINATION OF WHO AND WHAT CONSTITUTED THE SUBJECT OF HISTORY.

CHALLENGING ELITE-CENTRIC HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS

ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT IMPACTS OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO WAS ITS CHALLENGE TO THE PREVAILING ELITE-CENTRIC NATURE OF HISTORICAL WRITING. BY EMPHASIZING CLASS STRUGGLE AND THE EXPERIENCES OF THE PROLETARIAT, MARX AND ENGELS IMPLICITLY, AND OFTEN EXPLICITLY, ARGUED FOR THE IMPORTANCE OF UNDERSTANDING HISTORY FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE MASSES. THIS LED TO A GREATER FOCUS ON THE LIVES OF ORDINARY PEOPLE, WORKERS, PEASANTS, AND MARGINALIZED GROUPS, WHOSE EXPERIENCES HAD OFTEN BEEN OVERLOOKED OR DISMISSED IN TRADITIONAL HISTORIES. HISTORIANS INFLUENCED BY MARXISM BEGAN TO INVESTIGATE ECONOMIC CONDITIONS, SOCIAL MOVEMENTS, AND THE EVERYDAY LIVES OF THOSE AT THE BOTTOM OF THE SOCIAL HIERARCHY, THEREBY BROADENING THE SCOPE AND INCLUSIVITY OF HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS.

REINTERPRETING REVOLUTIONS AND SOCIAL UPHEAVALS

THE MANIFESTO'S ANALYSIS OF REVOLUTION AS A PRODUCT OF CLASS ANTAGONISM PROVIDED A NEW FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING MAJOR HISTORICAL UPHEAVALS. INSTEAD OF VIEWING REVOLUTIONS SOLELY AS POLITICAL EVENTS DRIVEN BY THE AMBITIONS OF LEADERS OR THE SPREAD OF ABSTRACT IDEAS, MARXIST-INFLUENCED HISTORIANS BEGAN TO INTERPRET THEM AS THE INEVITABLE OUTCOME OF DEEP-SEATED ECONOMIC CONTRADICTIONS AND CLASS CONFLICTS. THE FRENCH REVOLUTION, THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION, AND COUNTLESS OTHER HISTORICAL EVENTS WERE RE-EXAMINED THROUGH THE LENS OF CLASS STRUGGLE, WITH ANALYSES FOCUSING ON THE ECONOMIC GRIEVANCES OF DIFFERENT SOCIAL STRATA AND THE RESULTING POWER DYNAMICS. THIS APPROACH OFFERED A MORE MATERIALIST AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC EXPLANATION FOR THESE TRANSFORMATIVE PERIODS.

FOCUS ON ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES

THE EMPHASIS ON HISTORICAL MATERIALISM LED TO A SIGNIFICANT SHIFT IN HISTORICAL METHODOLOGY. HISTORIANS BEGAN TO PAY MUCH CLOSER ATTENTION TO ECONOMIC STRUCTURES, MODES OF PRODUCTION, AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF WEALTH AND RESOURCES. THE INTERNAL DYNAMICS OF ECONOMIC SYSTEMS, THE DEVELOPMENT OF TECHNOLOGY, AND THE IMPACT OF THESE FACTORS ON SOCIAL RELATIONS BECAME CENTRAL THEMES IN HISTORICAL INQUIRY. CONSEQUENTLY, HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS STARTED TO DELVE DEEPER INTO THE ECONOMIC UNDERPINNINGS OF POLITICAL DECISIONS, CULTURAL MOVEMENTS, AND SOCIAL CHANGES. THIS FOCUS ON UNDERLYING ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES PROVIDED A MORE COMPREHENSIVE AND NUANCED UNDERSTANDING OF HISTORICAL CAUSATION, MOVING BEYOND PURELY POLITICAL OR BIOGRAPHICAL EXPLANATIONS.

THE ADOPTION AND ADAPTATION OF MARXIST HISTORIOGRAPHY

THE INFLUENCE OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO WAS NOT LIMITED TO ITS DIRECT ADHERENTS; ITS CORE ANALYTICAL TOOLS WERE ADOPTED, ADAPTED, AND DEBATED BY A WIDE RANGE OF HISTORIANS, EVEN THOSE WHO REJECTED ITS COMMUNIST IDEOLOGY. THIS RESULTED IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF DISTINCT SCHOOLS OF MARXIST HISTORIOGRAPHY AND SIGNIFICANT CROSS-POLLINATION WITH OTHER HISTORICAL APPROACHES.

THE ANNALES SCHOOL AND SOCIAL HISTORY

IN FRANCE, THE ANNALES SCHOOL, FOUNDED BY MARC BLOCH AND LUCIEN FEBVRE, WHILE NOT STRICTLY MARXIST, SHARED A SIGNIFICANT INTELLECTUAL LINEAGE WITH MARXIST HISTORIOGRAPHY. THE ANNALES HISTORIANS ALSO MOVED AWAY FROM TRADITIONAL POLITICAL HISTORY TO FOCUS ON LONG-TERM SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC STRUCTURES, THE MENTALITIES OF PEOPLE, AND THE EVERYDAY LIVES OF ORDINARY INDIVIDUALS. THEIR CONCEPT OF "TOTAL HISTORY" ECHOED THE MARXIST AMBITION TO UNDERSTAND SOCIETY IN ITS ENTIRETY, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON MATERIAL CONDITIONS AND SOCIAL STRUCTURES. THE SHARED INTEREST IN SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC HISTORY, PARTICULARLY THE LIVES OF THE PEASANTRY AND THE URBAN POOR, DEMONSTRATES THE INDIRECT BUT SUBSTANTIAL INFLUENCE OF MARXIST IDEAS ON A MAJOR SCHOOL OF HISTORICAL THOUGHT.

THE RISE OF SUBALTERN STUDIES

THE INTELLECTUAL HERITAGE OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO ALSO PLAYED A CRUCIAL ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF SUBALTERN STUDIES. THIS FIELD OF SCHOLARSHIP, PARTICULARLY PROMINENT IN THE STUDY OF SOUTH ASIA, FOCUSES ON THE HISTORIES OF MARGINALIZED AND OPPRESSED GROUPS—THE "SUBALTERN." SCHOLARS IN THIS TRADITION, INFLUENCED BY MARXIST CONCEPTS OF CLASS STRUGGLE AND THE CRITIQUE OF DOMINANT NARRATIVES, SOUGHT TO RECOVER AND AMPLIFY THE VOICES AND EXPERIENCES OF THOSE EXCLUDED FROM MAINSTREAM HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS. THEY ANALYZED PEASANT REVOLTS, TRIBAL UPRISINGS, AND THE RESISTANCE OF VARIOUS MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES, DIRECTLY ENGAGING WITH THE MARXIST IMPERATIVE TO PRIORITIZE THE HISTORIES OF THE OPPRESSED. THE FOCUS ON POWER DYNAMICS AND RESISTANCE AT THE GRASSROOTS LEVEL IS A CLEAR INHERITANCE FROM THE FOUNDATIONAL IDEAS PRESENTED IN THE MANIFESTO.

INFLUENCES ON POST-COLONIAL HISTORIOGRAPHY

POST-COLONIAL HISTORIOGRAPHY HAS ALSO BEEN SIGNIFICANTLY SHAPED BY THE ANALYTICAL FRAMEWORK OFFERED BY THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO. THE MARXIST CRITIQUE OF CAPITALISM AND IMPERIALISM, WHICH VIEWED COLONIAL EXPANSION AS AN OUTGROWTH OF CAPITALIST DEVELOPMENT AND A TOOL FOR EXPLOITATION, PROVIDED A POWERFUL LENS FOR UNDERSTANDING THE HISTORY OF COLONIZATION AND ITS AFTERMATH. POST-COLONIAL HISTORIANS HAVE FREQUENTLY EMPLOYED MARXIST CONCEPTS TO ANALYZE THE ECONOMIC EXPLOITATION OF COLONIZED TERRITORIES, THE IMPOSITION OF FOREIGN ECONOMIC SYSTEMS, AND THE RESULTING CLASS FORMATIONS WITHIN FORMERLY COLONIZED SOCIETIES. THE CONCEPT OF THE PROLETARIAT AND THE BOURGEOISIE, WHEN APPLIED TO THE DYNAMICS BETWEEN COLONIZERS AND COLONIZED, OR BETWEEN ELITES AND THE MASSES IN POST-COLONIAL NATIONS, OFFERED A ROBUST WAY TO INTERPRET POWER STRUCTURES AND STRUGGLES FOR

LIBERATION. THE CRITIQUE OF HEGEMONY AND THE FOCUS ON RESISTANCE, CENTRAL TO POST-COLONIAL STUDIES, OWE MUCH TO THE THEORETICAL UNDERPINNINGS OF MARXIST THOUGHT, AS ARTICULATED IN THE MANIFESTO.

CRITIQUES AND COUNTER-ARGUMENTS TO MARXIST INTERPRETATIONS OF HISTORY

WHILE THE IMPACT OF THE COMMUNIST MANIFESTO ON HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS IS UNDENIABLE, ITS TENETS HAVE ALSO BEEN SUBJECT TO RIGOROUS CRITIQUE AND COUNTER-ARGUMENT. THESE CRITICISMS HAVE LED TO MODIFICATIONS, REJECTIONS, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF ALTERNATIVE THEORETICAL FRAMEWORKS FOR UNDERSTANDING THE PAST.

OVEREMPHASIS ON ECONOMICS AND DETERMINISM

ONE OF THE MOST PERSISTENT CRITICISMS OF MARXIST HISTORIOGRAPHY, STEMMING FROM THE MANIFESTO'S HISTORICAL MATERIALISM, IS ITS PERCEIVED OVEREMPHASIS ON ECONOMIC FACTORS TO THE EXCLUSION OF OTHER INFLUENCES. CRITICS ARGUE THAT THIS ECONOMIC DETERMINISM CAN LEAD TO A SIMPLISTIC UNDERSTANDING OF HISTORY, NEGLECTING THE ROLE OF CULTURE, IDEAS, RELIGION, INDIVIDUAL AGENCY, AND POLITICAL DECISIONS THAT ARE NOT SOLELY DRIVEN BY ECONOMIC IMPERATIVES. THE CHARGE OF DETERMINISM SUGGESTS THAT HISTORY IS REDUCED TO AN INEVITABLE UNFOLDING OF ECONOMIC FORCES, LEAVING LITTLE ROOM FOR HUMAN CHOICE OR CONTINGENCY. MANY HISTORIANS ARGUE THAT THIS APPROACH CAN FLATTEN THE COMPLEXITY OF HISTORICAL CAUSATION AND OVERLOOK THE NUANCED INTERPLAY OF VARIOUS FACTORS IN SHAPING EVENTS.

NEGLECT OF AGENCY AND INDIVIDUAL ACTION

RELATED TO THE CRITIQUE OF DETERMINISM IS THE ACCUSATION THAT MARXIST INTERPRETATIONS, IN THEIR FOCUS ON BROAD CLASS STRUCTURES AND ECONOMIC FORCES, TEND TO DOWNPLAY THE SIGNIFICANCE OF INDIVIDUAL AGENCY AND THE ACTIONS OF PARTICULAR PEOPLE IN SHAPING HISTORY. CRITICS CONTEND THAT WHILE ECONOMIC STRUCTURES PROVIDE A CONTEXT, IT IS OFTEN THE CHOICES AND ACTIONS OF INDIVIDUALS—LEADERS, INNOVATORS, REBELS—THAT INITIATE OR DIRECT HISTORICAL CHANGE. BY PRIORITIZING COLLECTIVE ACTORS LIKE CLASSES, MARXIST ACCOUNTS MIGHT INADVERTENTLY OBSCURE THE CRUCIAL ROLE OF INDIVIDUAL INITIATIVE, CREATIVITY, AND EVEN ACCIDENT IN THE HISTORICAL PROCESS. THIS HAS LED SOME HISTORIANS TO ADVOCATE FOR APPROACHES THAT GIVE GREATER WEIGHT TO BIOGRAPHY AND THE SPECIFIC ACTIONS OF INDIVIDUALS WITHIN THEIR SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONTEXTS.

CHALLENGES FROM POST-STRUCTURALISM AND OTHER THEORIES

IN MORE RECENT DECADES, THE RISE OF POST-STRUCTURALIST THOUGHT AND OTHER CRITICAL THEORIES HAS POSED SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES TO TRADITIONAL MARXIST HISTORIOGRAPHY. THEORIES THAT EMPHASIZE THE INSTABILITY OF MEANING, THE FLUIDITY OF IDENTITY, AND THE IMPORTANCE OF DISCOURSE HAVE QUESTIONED THE FOUNDATIONAL ASSUMPTIONS OF HISTORICAL MATERIALISM AND CLASS ANALYSIS. POST-STRUCTURALIST APPROACHES, FOR INSTANCE, TEND TO DECONSTRUCT GRAND NARRATIVES AND UNIVERSALIZING CLAIMS, INCLUDING THE TELEOLOGICAL PROGRESSION OF HISTORY ENVISIONED IN THE MANIFESTO. FURTHERMORE, SCHOLARS HAVE DEVELOPED ALTERNATIVE FRAMEWORKS, SUCH AS FEMINIST HISTORY, CULTURAL HISTORY, AND QUEER HISTORY, WHICH BRING DIFFERENT LENSES TO BEAR ON THE PAST, OFTEN HIGHLIGHTING ASPECTS OF SOCIAL EXPERIENCE THAT WERE NOT PRIMARY CONCERNS IN CLASSICAL MARXIST ANALYSIS. THESE DIVERSE THEORETICAL DEVELOPMENTS HAVE BROADENED THE INTELLECTUAL LANDSCAPE AND OFFERED NEW WAYS TO INTERPRET HISTORICAL ACCOUNTS, SOMETIMES IN DIRECT DIALOGUE WITH, AND SOMETIMES IN OPPOSITION TO, MARXIST FRAMEWORKS.
